Inscription Details:

- **Print clearly with all CAPITAL letters.** Spaces and hyphens are counted as characters. Some common symbols (such as a heart) can be used, but each must be cleared by the manufacturer.
- **There is no need for you to center your own lettering.** This will be done automatically when bricks are engraved.
- **You will receive an email confirmation – please reply to confirm the inscription is correct.** Later, you will receive a packet with a formal certificate (to use as a gift presentation) and a donation amount letter for your records.
- **If you need a certificate by a specific date, let us know.** We try to fulfill special requests. For special requests or questions, please email mail@folq.org or leave a voicemail at 781-486-3795.

Newly engraved bricks are installed annually in late spring. Brick Dedication Ceremonies are held on alternate years. Ceremonies will be held in the spring of 2027, 2029, 2031, and so on. Mail your application by March 1st to guarantee your brick will be installed that same year. The committee has the right to refuse any inscription that is deemed inappropriate for this project.
